## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Growing Suburbs Fund will help Mornington Peninsula Shire Council deliver the first Changing Places facility for the Mornington Peninsula.

This facility will provide people of all abilities with dignified access to changing facilities, and enable more people to participate in social and recreational opportunities.

The Changing Places facility will include an electric height adjustable adult sized changing bench, an electric hoisting system, and enough room on both sides of the bench for a carer to assist.
